# No pedaling for ten miles!

A 20 mile ride from the top of Cabbage Hill back into Pendleton, almost all downhill! We'll even shuttle you to the top, for free!

Riders must have a helmet and bicycle in good working order, water, and must be at least 13 years old if accompanied by a parent. Riders 16 and over are not required to have parental accompaniment. Riders will be required to sign a safety pledge and waiver (parental signature required if less than 18). The ride is escorted and controlled by experienced riders from the Pendleton on Wheels Bicycle Club. Those attempting to ride unsafely will be immediately removed from the ride. Those not wanting to do the whole ride can catch a bus from Mission Market back to Community Park.

There will also be a **free bicycle clinic** for those needing their bike checked out before the ride on **Saturday August 21**. This will be held at the former Pendleton Music House, 337 SW Emigrant Ave. from 3 PM to 5 PM. Bike mechanics from the bike club will be available to check out your bike and perform minor adjustments if necessary. Donations will be accepted for any work done.

### Ride schedule:

- \* **7:30 – 8:30 AM:** Meet at Community Park for bike safety checks. Load bikes on truck to be hauled to Poverty Flats on Cabbage Hill.
- \* **8:15 – 8:30 AM:** Load bus to transport all riders to Poverty Flat road. Bus leaves promptly at 8:30. Your bike needs to be checked for safety and loaded on the truck before this time.
- \* **9:00 AM:** Depart Poverty Flat on the old cabbage hill road towards Pendleton.
- \* **10:00 AM:** The bus and bike truck will stop at the Mission Market to pick up those wishing to be driven back to Community Park. All others continue towards Pendleton on Mission Road.
- \* Plan to spend the rest of the day at Community Park – activities all day long for all ages, food and music too! Check out [www.pendletonparksandrec.com](http://www.pendletonparksandrec.com) for all of the details.

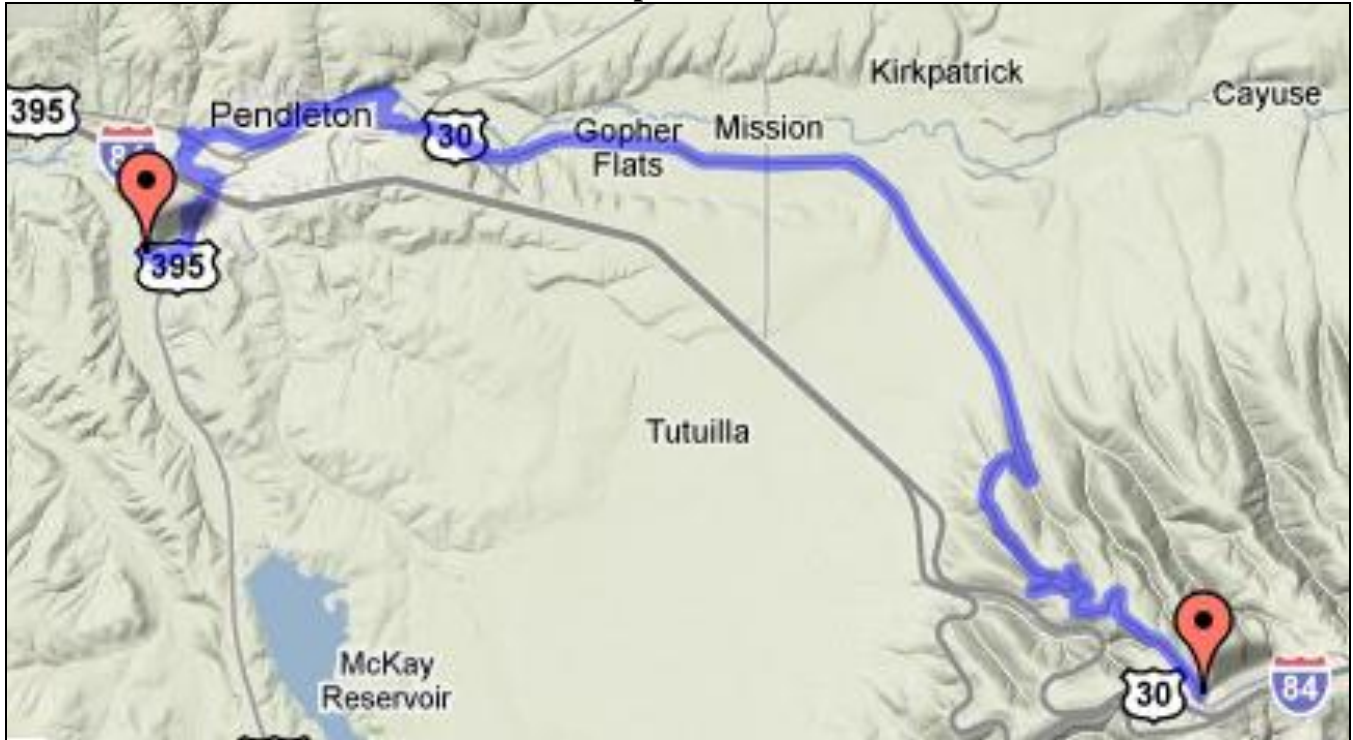
**Advance registration is required. The ride is limited to 55.**
